# ADDITIONAL FEES, APPLICATION AND ENROLMENT INFORMATION

#### 1. IB Diploma Fees:

IB DP Exam fees may be subject to change based on the latest rates published by IB. Students are charged accordingly for the exams they take.

#### 2. The graduation fee:

Covers a range of expenses related to the ceremony and associated events. This may include the cost of the cap, gown, and tassel; diploma printing and covers; venue setup, decorations, sound, and lighting; as well as professional photography or videography. Additionally, part of the fee may go toward the administrative time and staffing needed to organize and run graduation smoothly.

#### 3. International Student Guardianship Canada: (ISGC):

Citizenship and Immigration Canada requires international students studying in Canada to have a legal guardian in place, who is a Canadian citizen, holds a PR card, and/or holds a work permit and/or study permit, from a recognized institution.

Our partners at ISGC specialize in providing superior guardianship services to our international students. The appointed student guardian will closely follow the well being and success of each student as they adjust to their new school environment, and throughout the student's stay in Canada. Muli-lingual support for students and their families are offered 24 hours, 7 days a week, and maintain open communications between school administration, parents, and students. ISGC will also track and assist students with Study Permit renewals, and are available, (at an additional cost to the student/family) to assist with immigration support through a registered immigration consultant, including all travel visas, to new and returning students.

## 4. Application Fee:

All applications must be submitted through our online portal, <u>Open Apply</u>. All applications submitted will be required to pay \$300 to submit for Admissions review.

#### 5. Eligibility for Local Day Fees:

Fees are based on the primary residence (outside of Canada) of the parent(s).

To qualify for Canadian fees, a student must be/have:

- A dependent of a Canadian Citizen
- Have a parent(s) with a valid Study Permit (from a recognized institution), or Work permit.
- Have a parent(s) with diplomatic status
- Have a parent(s) with refugee status

#### 6. Enrolment Deposit and Annual Tuition:

Once a student receives an Offer of Enrolment from our Admissions Department, a non-refundable enrolment deposit is due within 2-weeks of the offer letter sent (dates may vary depending on date of offer). The enrolment deposit paid, will be deducted from the annual tuition fees, and will be reflected on your statement of fees.

#### Non refundable Enrolment Deposit:

• International Boarding Students: \$3,000

• Day students: \$1,000

#### **Balance of Annual Tuition Fees:**

- International Students: balance of tuition fees is due 2-weeks after the enrolment deposit has been received.
- Day Students: balance of tuition fees, can be made in one full payment, or 10 monthly payments (September June).

#### 7. **Study Permit**:

International students must obtain a study permit, valid for the academic year. Once the student has received approval, a copy must be emailed to <a href="mailto:admissions@sjasl.ca">admissions@sjasl.ca</a>, prior to arrival on campus. Without a valid study permit, students will not be eligible to receive credits towards their Graduation Diploma.

## 8. Annual Administration fees:

Administration fees, as listed in the fee table, under School Fees, are contributed towards campus improvement funds, experiential learning enhancements, field trips, and additional administrative costs.

#### 9. **Medical Fees** (for international students):

All international students with a study permit valid for a period of six or more months are required to apply for the British Columbia Medical Services Plan (BC MSP), as soon as they arrive in Canada. Student Medical Insurance fees outlined, include the cost of private medical coverage through <u>StudyInsured</u>, upon landing in Canada, plus the submission of the BC MSP application and annual BC MSP fees.

# 10. Sibling Discount:

Families with more than one child enrolled in grades 4 to 12 will receive a 5% discount on each of the younger sibling's Annual Tuition, *not* the Total Annual Tuition Fees.

# 11. Student Deferrals:

*Enrolled* student's may be eligible for a <u>one-time</u> opportunity to defer attendance to the next academic year. Requests are reviewed on a case-by-case basis and subject to available space the following academic year.
